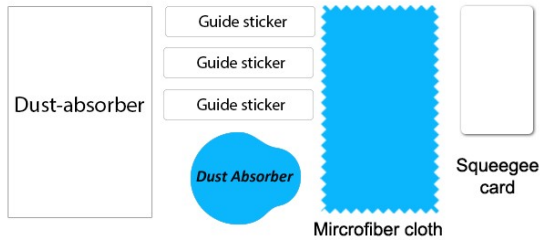


Tips and tricks for installing

Before handling the Screen Protectors, make sure you wash your hands with a grease removing dish detergent. Also, clean the area around your workspace to keep the area as dust free as possible. Use the included White Dust-absorber to remove any dust from the screen and surrounding area by peeling off the back and using the sticky side to lift any dust away from the screen and surrounding areas. Then use the micro fiber cloth to clean the screen until you can't see any fingerprints or oil spots on the screen.



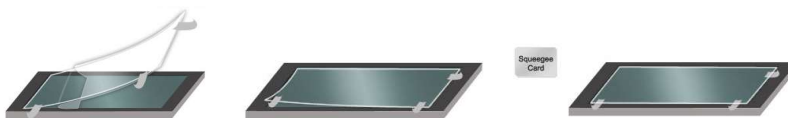
Before peeling the backing layer of the Screen Protector off use the Guide Stickers included in the install kit applied lightly on the front of the screen protector to use as tabs, so you can grab them instead of the screen protector itself when applying to your screen, so you don't leave any fingerprints. Also, this helps if it doesn't lay straight the first time you can easily lift the screen protector back off to center it again.

3 Layers

1. Top Protective Layer (tab number 2)
2. Actual PET Screen Protector
3. Backing Layer (tab number 1)



These Guide Sticker tabs can also help you if you get dust under the screen protector. Using the tabs, you can lift off or roll back the screen protector to expose the dust and use the included small blue color dust absorber to lightly pick up the dust or hair stuck to the bottom of screen protector. Once you have all dust particles removed and the screen protector in place the way you would like, pull the number 2 tab to remove the Top Protective layer stickers off slowly it should come off easily without leaving any residue.



If you have air bubbles use the included white card to gently smooth out the bubbles pushing from the center of the applied screen protector out to the closest edge of the screen protector you should not need to apply much force to remove the bubbles they should easily be pushed out if there is no dust stuck to the back of the screen protectors.
